The curves and summary measures shown on the right (in plain font) are from one segment (about 3 Km long) of the 100 km on-road driving test that commenced at 40 minutes after consumption of the indicated products. CBD: cannabidiol; THC: Δ 9-tetrahydrocannabinol. Galton's index measures by how much the length of the trace exceeds the straight line distance (excess expressed here as parts per million). The measures of weaving shown in bold on the left are weighted averages over all 20 segments.
